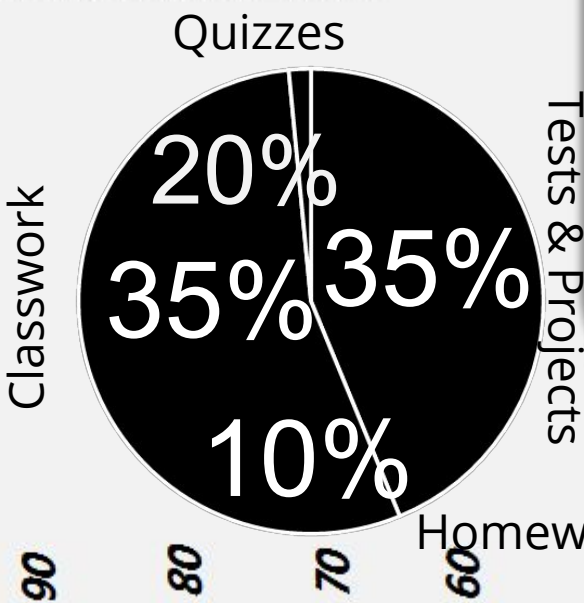
Restroom

You are issued 2 passes per 6 weeks per class. Using the restroom is at the teacher's discretion and no more than 2 passes will be given.

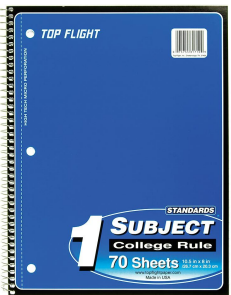
POLICIES
