PARENT GRADE NOTIFICATION

Teachers are not permitted to give this information.

LATE WORK POLICY

IXL Disclaimer: All IXL assignments will be due on the given due date without the option of late submissions.

Student work completion and responsibility is priority at the middle school level. This is encouraged and reinforced by a late work policy that challenges students to be self-directed and responsible as they improve their academic growth.

All assignments are expected to be turned in by the Due Date which must be posted in Power School next to the assignment name. Assignments not turned in by the Due Date will be penalized for up to 3 days.

Day 1- Late Work Penalty: may earn no more than 90%

Day 2- Late Work Penalty: may earn no more than 80%

Day 3 (DEADLINE)- Late Work Penalty: may earn no more than 70%

The DEADLINE is 3 days beyond the Due Date and no work will be accepted beyond that point. *Special consideration may be given to students who request it in writing to their teacher.* This will be a teacher decision under those circumstances. The students must request this for any special consideration.
