Pre-Calculus Honors Syllabus Ms. Powers

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The purpose of this course is to emphasize the study of functions and other skills necessary for the study of calculus at the college level. The content should include, but not be limited to the following: polynomial, rational, exponential, inverse, logarithmic, and circular functions; sequences and series; concept of limits; vectors; conic sections; polar coordinate systems; symbolic logic; mathematical induction; matrix algebra; and trigonometry.

Keys to Success

- 1. Complete assignments daily.

- 3. Study daily. Read the section before beginning the homework.
- 4. Ask questions to clarify difficulties. Get help the SAME day.
- 5. Maintain consistent attendance.
