1. **To Cheat** - Cheating is defined as "the actual giving or receiving of any unauthorized aid or assistance or the giving or receiving of any unfair advantage regarding any form of academic work."
2. **To Steal** - Plagiarism is also stealing. Plagiarism is defined as "copying the language, structure, ideas, or thoughts of another, and passing off the same as one's original work."
3. **Falsification** - "statement of any untruth, either spoken or written, regarding any circumstances relative to academic work"
4. **Multiple Submission** - The submission of substantial portions of the same academic work for credit more than once without authorization from the faculty member who receives the later submission.
5. **Violation Assistance** – is knowingly helping or attempting to help someone else in an act that constitutes an academic integrity violation.
6. **Violation Attempts** – is attempting any act regardless if it is completed, would constitute an academic integrity violation(that is cheating, stealing, plagiarism, falsification, multiple submission, violation assistance).
