It is a violation of the Honor Code

- 1. **To Cheat** Cheating is defined as "the actual giving or receiving of any unauthorized aid or assistance or the giving or receiving of any unfair advantage regarding any form of academic work."
- 2. **To Steal** Plagiarism is also stealing. Plagiarism is defined as "copying the language, structure, ideas, or thoughts of another, and passing off the same as one's original work."
- 3. **Falsification** "statement of any untruth, either spoken or written, regarding any circumstances relative to academic work"
- 4. **Multiple Submission** The submission of substantial portions of the same academic work for credit more than once without authorization from the faculty member who receives the later submission.
- 5. **Violation Assistance** is knowingly helping or attempting to help someone else in an act that constitutes an academic integrity violation.
- 6. **Violation Attempts** is attempting any act regardless if it is completed, would constitute an academic integrity violation(that is cheating, stealing, plagiarism, falsification, multiple submission, violation assistance).
