The AP Calculus AB second semester course is a continuation of the Advanced Topics Calculus AB from first semester. Course Description and Philosophy remain the same from the first semester syllabus.

AP Test Details:


The AP test is currently scheduled on **Monday**, **May 8**, **2023** at **8am**. The following is the *typical layout of the test, but is subject to change*.

The AP test consists of 2 parts:

Section I -- Multiple Choice (105 minutes) 30 questions, 60 minutes, no calculator allowed 15 questions, 45 minutes, calculator required Section II -- Free Response (90 Minutes) 4 questions, 60 minutes, no calculator allowed 2 questions, 30 minutes, calculator required *work must be shown, even when a calculator is used

***All enrolled students for second semester are required to take the AP test in May or a drop in letter grade is made.

A 3, 4 or 5 on the AP exam constitutes a passing score. More information can be found at: http://www.collegeboard.com/student/testing/ap/about.html
