STUDENT LEAP Account

Students do not have an actual card. They must provide their student ID number to check out items.



The student's PIN is their four digit year of birth. This should help the student renew the maximum of

2 times

or use self-checkout machines.

Elementary School Students: Juvenile Only

- 10 items from the Juvenile Department only.
- No DVDs.
- Regular loan period.
- No late fees. Damaged or lost fees will apply.
- Use of Children's computers.

Middle School Students: Juvenile

- 10 items from any department.
- No DVDs.
- Regular loan period.
- No late fees. Damaged or lost fees will apply.
- Use of Children's computers.

If the student is 13 years of age, they may be issued a free pass for adult computers after staff has verified DOB through their LEAP account.

High School Students: Teens

- 10 items from any department.
- No DVDs.
- Regular loan period.
- No late fees. Damaged or lost fees will apply.
- Use of adult computers.
