Math II Classroom Expectations
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## Grades

- Term grades are calculated with homework being $40 \%$ and assessments (tests/quizzes) being $60 \%$.
- The semester grade is calculated with each term being 25\%, for a total of $75 \%$ and the NCFE being $25 \%$.
- Grades are updated at least once a week in PowerSchool. Students have an individual username and password. Parents/guardians may also get a username and password through the main office.

## Homework, Absences and Assessments

$>$ Homework is due the next class period unless noted otherwise. Homework will be collected as deemed necessary, so it is a good idea to complete each assignment. Papers that only have answers will not be accepted. Late work (not due to absence) will be accepted for 3 days with penalty. On the 4th day and later, no credit will be given. Homework will be checked together in class. Students should ask questions about problems they do not understand or worked incorrectly.
> If you are absent it is your responsibility to make up the work you missed in the time provided in compliance with UCPS policy. Be sure your notebook is up to date with all notes you missed. Information can be found in Canvas or from classmates. Do not hesitate to ask me what you missed while absent.
> Students will be assessed in a variety of ways including warm ups, exit tickets, quizzes and unit tests. If students are unhappy with the grade earned, they may arrange to do corrections with teacher assistance during Pirate Prep or tutoring before/after school. Corrections will allow the student to earn back $50 \%$ of the points missed.

## Tutoring Days and Times

$>$ Tuesday after school until 4 and before school Tuesday/Thursday starting at 7:30.
$>$ Other times may be requested (in advance if possible).

## Expectations

$>$ Be in your seat ready to learn...have your homework out and pencils sharpened before the tardy bell.
$>$ Restroom visits should be for emergencies only. You will need to sign out and back in.
$>$ When I am talking, you are not talking.
> Please raise your hand to be excused from your seat or if you have a question.
$>$ NO phones, iPods, earbuds, headphones, eating or drinking (with the exception of water) in class

$>$ Discipline referrals will be written as necessary.
